

Bass Compliance Direction - 2021

Council Regulation (EU) 2020/123 was released on the 27th January 2020. Article 10 specifies the **Measures on European seabass fisheries**. This regulation was amended by section 3 of The Common Fisheries Policy (Amendment etc) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 and section 2 of The Sea Fisheries (Amendment etc) Regulations 2021. These are not byelaw restrictions introduced by D&S IFCA, but they do apply within the D&S IFCA District.

Below is a summary from Article 10 for the European Sea Bass (*Dicentrarchus labrax*) Measures for 2021. These measures apply to the whole of the Devon and Severn IFCA District including within the estuaries. Detailed guidance on the implementation of the bass measures for 2021 is available [here](#).

In the first instant, the legislation prohibits Union fishing vessels, as well as commercial fishers from the shore, fishing for, retaining, transshipping, relocating, and landing bass caught in different ICES areas including the area within the D&S IFCA District.

- 1. There is no fishing for bass in February and March.**
- 2. Commercial fisheries require gear specific authorisation by the MMO to catch and retain bass.**

By way of derogation to the 1st paragraph in the legislation, fishing is possible with restrictions dependant on different gear types, and where more than one gear type is used in a single calendar month, the lowest catch limit applies.

Gear Type & Restriction

Demersal Trawls

Unavoidable by-catches not exceeding 380 kilogrammes per month and 5% of the weight of the total catches of marine organisms on board caught by that vessel per fishing trip.

Seine Nets:

Unavoidable by-catches not exceeding 380 kilogrammes per month and 5% of the weight of the total catches of marine organisms on board caught by that vessel per fishing trip.

Hooks and Lines:

Amounts not exceeding 5.7 tonnes per vessel per year.

Fixed Gillnets:

By-catches not exceeding 1.4 tonnes per vessel per year.

This prohibition does not apply to by-catches in shore-based fixed gillnets that are not set from a vessel of —

(a) up to 1 net in relation to the IFC authority for Devon and Severn

Minimum Conservation Reference Size (MCRS)

This remains at 42cm and applies to commercial and recreational fishers.

Recreational Fishing

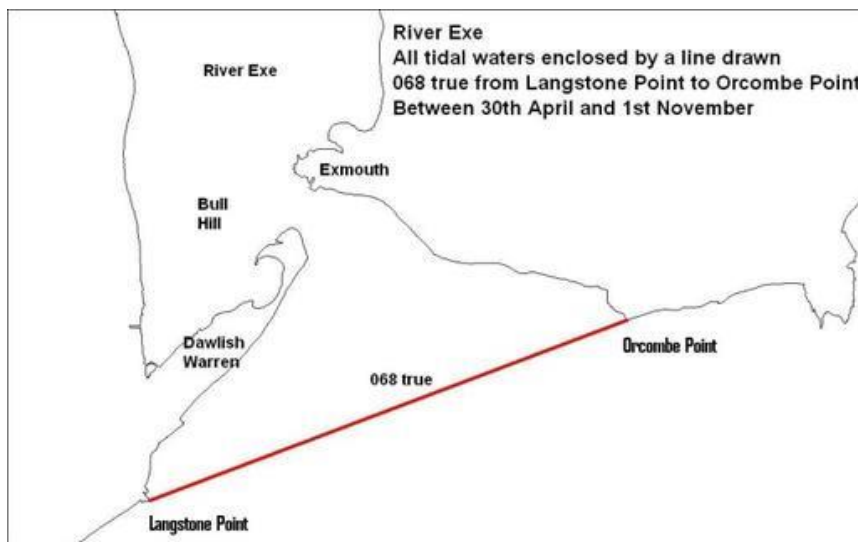
Catch and Release only in the months of January, February, and December.

- 2 bass per fisher, per day during the months March to November inclusive.
- Fixed nets cannot be used to catch or retain bass.

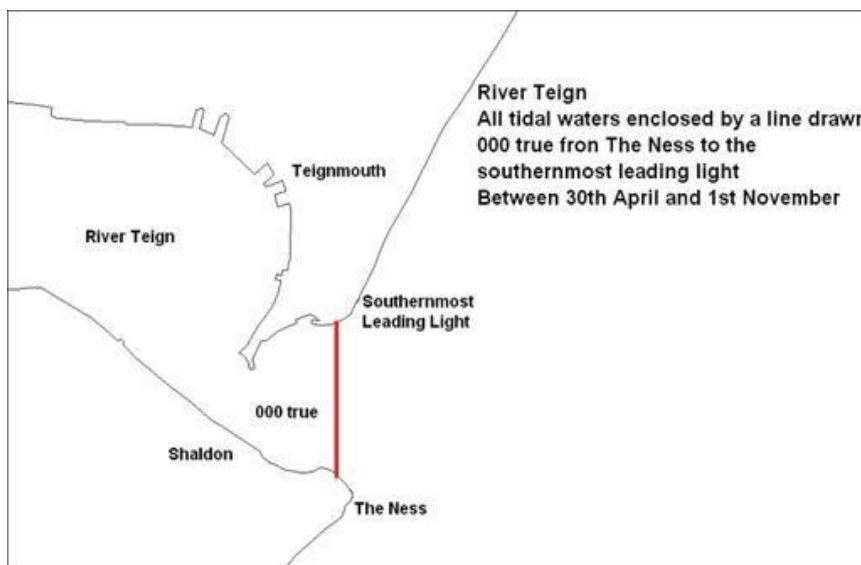
Bass Nursery Areas

These are set out within the Bass (Specified Areas) (Prohibition of Fishing) (Variation) Order 1999. There are restrictions on fishing for Bass in different areas at certain times of the year, including a prohibition on the use of Sand Eels (*Ammodytidae spp*) as bait.

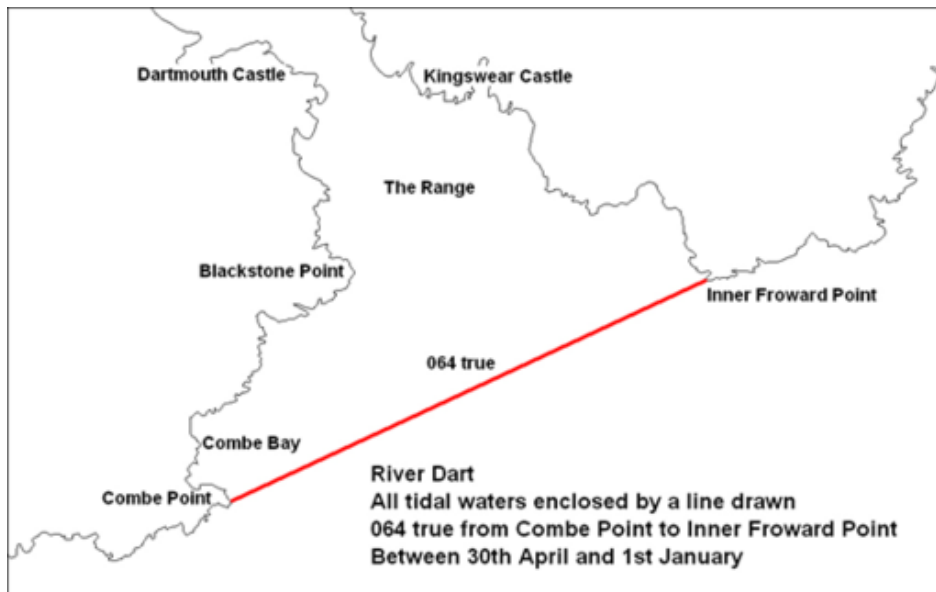
River Exe: Fishing for bass, or fishing for any species of sea fish using Sand Eels (*Ammodytidae spp*) as bait, by any fishing boat within any part of the River Exe Bass Nursery Area is **prohibited between 30th April and 1st November.**



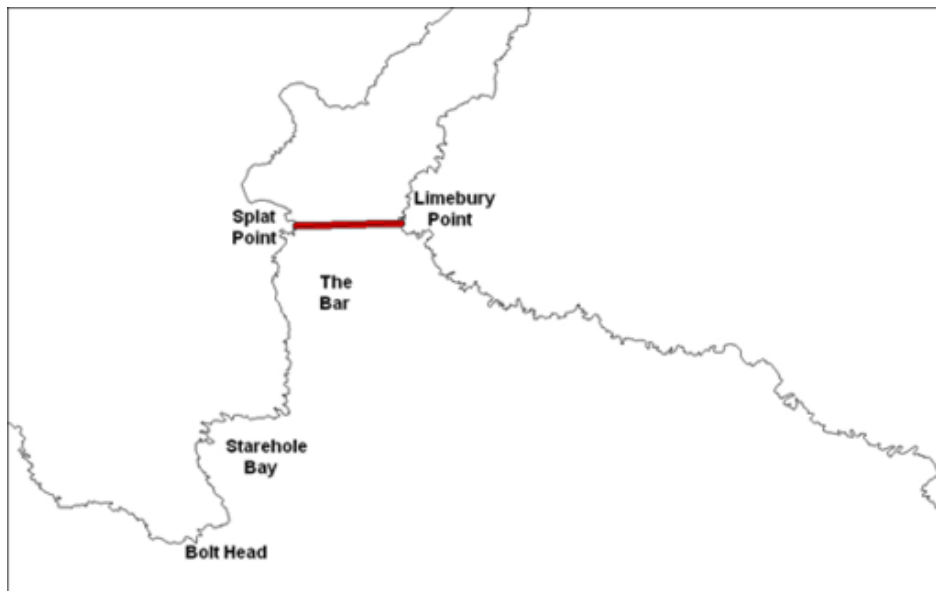
River Teign: Fishing for bass, or fishing for any species of sea fish using Sand Eels (*Ammodytidae spp*) as bait, by any fishing boat within any part of the River Teign Bass Nursery area is **prohibited between 30th April and 1st November.**



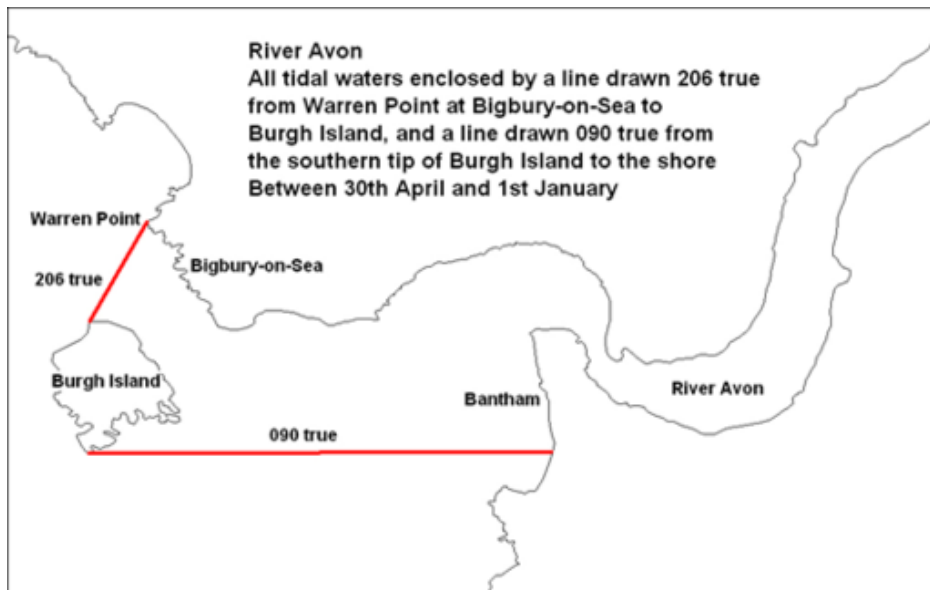
River Dart: Fishing for bass, or fishing for any species of sea fish using Sand Eels (*Ammodytidae spp*) as bait, by any fishing boat within any part of the River Dart Bass Nursery Area is **prohibited** between **30th April and 1st January**.



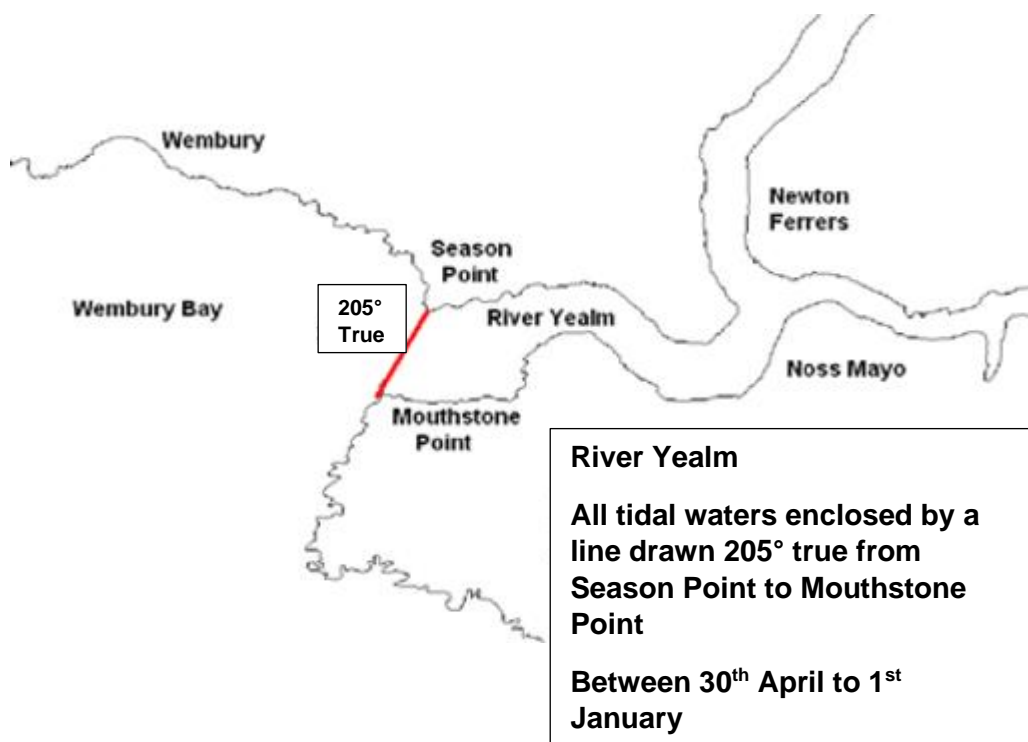
Salcombe Harbour and the Kingsbridge Estuary: Fishing for bass, or fishing for any species of sea fish using Sand Eels (*Ammodytidae spp*) as bait, by any fishing boat within any part of the Salcombe Harbour and Kingsbridge Estuary Bass Nursery Area is **prohibited** between **30th April and 1st January**.



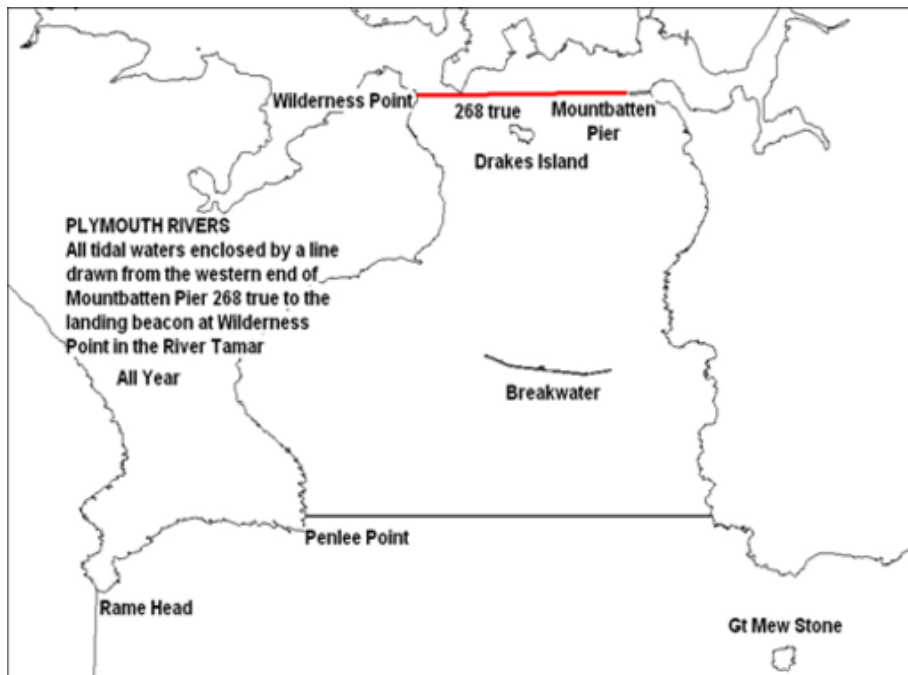
River Avon: Fishing for bass, or fishing for any species of sea fish using Sand Eels (*Ammodytidae spp*) as bait, by any fishing boat within any part of the River Avon Bass Nursery Area is **prohibited** between **30th April and 1st January**.



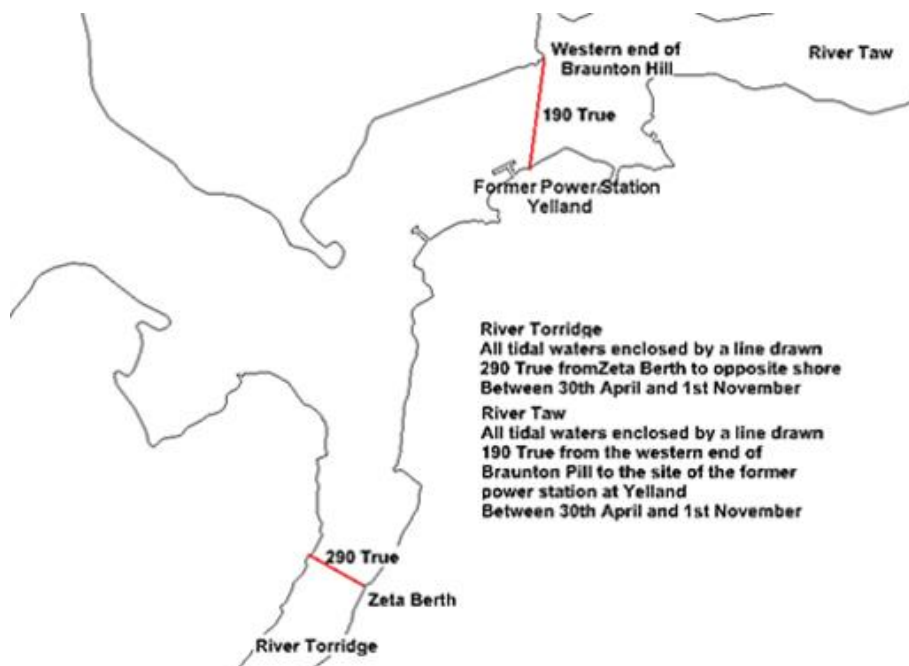
River Yealm: Fishing for bass, or fishing for any species of sea fish using Sand Eels (*Ammodytidae spp*) as bait, by any fishing boat within any part of the River Yealm Bass Nursery Area is **prohibited** between **30th April and 1st January**.



Plymouth Rivers Tamar and Plym: Fishing for bass, or fishing for any species of sea fish using Sand Eels (*Ammodytidae spp*) as bait, by any fishing boat within any part of the Plymouth Rivers Bass Nursery Area is **prohibited all year**.



River Taw and River Torridge: Fishing for bass, or fishing for any species of sea fish using Sand Eels (*Ammodytidae spp*) as bait, by any fishing boat within any part of the River Taw and River Torridge Bass Nursery Areas between **30th April and 1st November**.



Enforcement

Any person found breaching the legislation outlined above may be subject to enforcement action including receiving a Financial Administrative Penalty (FAP) or court proceedings.
