Budget Monitoring Month 4

The Budget monitoring at Month 4 indicates there will be an overall overspend against budget for the year.

The overspend in employees is mainly due to the salary costs for a new fixed term post within the team.

Whilst there is an indication of an overspend, there are areas which have seen an underspend. Due to COVID restrictions that have been in place, there has been less usage of public transport, as well as the need to travel for meetings and conferences. In Supplies and Services, there are no major advertising costs. Furthermore, there has been an increase in virtual calls, which has resulted in a reduction in telephone costs.
