**NOTICE OF APPEAL MADE UNDER THE ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING
(ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 2016 – REGULATION 31**

I hereby give you notice of an appeal which has been made to the Secretary of State by NNB Generation Company (HPC) Limited. The appeal is against the Environment Agency's non-determination of a permit application to vary conditions for a site at Hinkley Point C, Somerset.

The appeal to the Secretary of State will be heard by the Planning Inspectorate (PINS) which has powers delegated by the Secretary of State to deal with environmental permit appeals.
