Plymouth Sound and Estuaries Marine Recreation Survey

Do you spend time in, on, under or near the water? If so, Footprint ecology would like you to complete a short online survey about recreation in our blue spaces.

D&S IFCA have been advised of a new online recreational survey being conducted by Footprint Ecology as part of the Recreation Mitigation and Management Scheme by Plymouth City Council.

The survey aims to find out how people use the Plymouth Sound and Estuaries European Marine Site for outdoor recreation. This survey builds on the original study that was carried out in 2016/17.
