Overview:

NW IFCA is one of the largest of ten IFCAs in England. The NW IFCA District spans 8 local authority boundaries from Wirral, Halton, Cheshire, Liverpool, and Sefton in the south along the Lancashire and Blackpool coasts to the west coast of Cumbria where the Lake District meets the Irish Sea. Locally based Fishery Officers and their fishery patrol vessels ensure that NW IFCA byelaws and national legislation is enforced throughout the area and up to 6 nautical miles offshore.

Job Purpose and Detail:

The Chief Executive will lead 21 dedicated staff and report to the Authority membership of 30 representatives appointed by each Local Authority, as well as fishing industry and environmental experts appointed by the Marine Management Organisation. The successful candidate will represent the Authority at all levels from local meetings with fishermen through to meetings with UK Ministers and the devolved administrations in Wales and Scotland.
