## Sand Eel Trawling – Have Your Say

D&S IFCA is inviting you to have your say on the development of Mobile Fishing Byelaw Permit Conditions to manage the activity of sand eel trawling for both commercial and recreational fishers.



We are directly contacting everyone on our mailing list and are giving you options on how to respond. All stakeholders can respond even if they don't conduct the activity.

The information gathering exercise ends on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

D&S IFCA have produced some information about the proposals and set out some background information which you can read in full <a href="here">here</a> by opening the pdf document. The circulated information includes the initial proposals, links (if reading in electronic format) to further information and explains how you can participate in the process. This information gathering exercise is based around six questions that are set out after some background information.

The proposals include developing catch, gear and spatial permit conditions that would be relevant to different fishers who could qualify for either a commercial (Category 3) or recreational (Category 4) permit; however, all fishers would need to use a vessel below seven metres in overall length in order to conduct the activity.
