

Bycatch of Shad

Returning and reporting



Please remember: any shad must be returned to the sea as soon as possible after the catch occurs

Under the Wildlife and Countryside Act (1981, as amended), from 0nm to 12 nm, it is illegal to:

- Kill or injure,
- Take,
- Damage or destroy the place of resting, shelter or breeding of, any allis shad (*Alosa alosa*) or twaite shad (*Alosa fallax*).

Devon and Severn IFCA is collecting data on Shad bycatch in order to monitor their populations. Please get in contact if you see shad bycatch in your gear.
