


Figure 1. Catch composition for each haul of a gillnet in 2023 during D&S IFCA's bass survivability study. There was no catch in hauls 1, 5 and 6 so these are not displayed. Haul locations are outlined in Figures 2 and 3 (overleaf).




Figure 2. Sequentially numbered hauls of gillnets conducted in January 2023, showing hauls conducted north of a line between Snapes Point and Scoble Point (hauls 1-4 and 8-13).




Figure 3. Sequentially numbered hauls of gillnets conducted in January 2023, showing hauls conducted south of a line between Snapes Point and Scoble Point (hauls 5-7).

This document details the catch composition for each haul of the gillnets during Devon and Severn IFCA's study of bass survivability in January 2023 (Henly and Stewart, 2023), intended to demonstrate catch composition (Figure 1) at different locations in the study site (Figures 2 and 3).
