Environmental Officers Attend Exe Estuary Winter Forum

Environment officers attended the Exe Estuary Winter Form at County Hall, Exeter.





The Exe Estuary Management Partnership holds two for a year (a winter and summer forum). The forum meetings enable discussions and provide information on topical Exe Estuary issues.

The winter forum provides a formal opportunity to inform local residents and stakeholders on the latest management of the Exe. D&S IFCA attends these forums in order to share information regarding any fishery management on the Exe and answer any questions the local communities may have. The meeting which was held on 4th February was well attended and included presentations on the local flood defence schemes, pacific oyster project being run by the Exe Management Partnership, and a trial of a mixed shellfishery at Lympstone.

D&S IFCA attends various estuary fora in order to engage with local stakeholders. These include: Yealm; Kingsbridge-Salcombe; Dart, Avon and Plymouth Sound (TECF).
