



D&S IFCA Declarations of Interest Form

The completion of this form confirms an understanding and agreement with the three statements below (A, B, and C).

A) Disclosable Pecuniary Interests

As a Member of Devon and Severn Inshore Fisheries and Conservation Authority (D&S IFCA), I give notice below of those interests which I am required to declare under The Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012 and D&S IFCA's Code of Conduct. I understand that in so doing I must declare any interest of my spouse or civil partner or of any person with whom I am living as a husband or wife and also, in relation to the categories below, and so far as you are aware of any or relevant person as defined in section 30(3)(b) of the Localism Act 2011.

B) Sensitive Interests

I understand that if disclosing an interest could lead to me or a connected person being subjected to violence or intimidation, I can apply for the interest to be treated as a "sensitive interest". In such cases, the details will be excluded from the public register (not published), although I must still disclose that an interest exists at meetings.

- I understand that sensitive Interests should be disclosed directly to the Clerk and not as part of this form.

C) Other Registrable Interests

In addition, as a Member of D&S IFCA I give notice of those interests where a reasonable person with knowledge of the relevant facts would regard the Member, their relatives, or their close friends as having an interest in any business of the D&S IFCA being considered. The declaration of an interest is required where the matter affects the financial interest or well-being of the Member, their relatives or close friends to a greater extent than it affects the financial interests of the majority of the public in the area affected by the decision such that it is likely to prejudice your view of the wider public interest.

Land

Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the D&S IFCA's District.

Licences

Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the D&S IFCA's District for a month or longer.

Corporate tenancies

Any tenancy where (to the Member's knowledge)—

- (a) the landlord is the relevant authority; and*
- (b) the tenant is a body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest.*

Securities

Any beneficial interest in securities of a body where—

- (a) that body (to the Member's knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the relevant authority; and
- (b) either—(i) the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or
- (ii) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.
